Tawaf: Circling the Kaaba seven times.

Sa'i: Walking seven times between the hills of Safa and Marwah.

Halq or Taqsir: Shaving or cutting a portion of the hair.

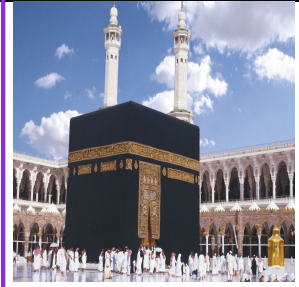

Quba Mosque: The first mosque built in Islam.

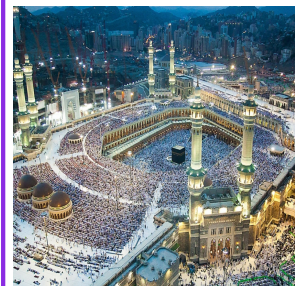
Mount Uhud: Site of the famous Battle of Uhud.
