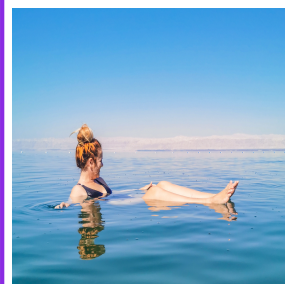
First Day :Day 1: Queen Alia Airport – Madaba – Mount Nebo - Dead Sea overnight

Welcome to Jordan! After your arrival in Jordan, our representative will be by your side to assist you in all procedures inside the airport & will guide you to your transfer

Distance: 42 min (35.8 km) Start your day with a visit to Madaba, known as the "City of Mosaics" for its Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Visit St. George's Church, home to the famous 6th-century mosaic map of Palestine, an invaluable piece of early Christian art.

Distance: 15 min (9.0 km) Then you'll heading to Mount Nebo: Mount Nebo is the highest point in the ancient Kingdom of Moab, referenced in Abrahamic texts as the site of Mount Nebo this township was first inhabited by a Christian nomadic tribe in the 4th century. Explore the roots of a religious town or visit Mt. Nebo where it is believed that Moses died as he viewed the Holy Land. "And Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho

Distance: 23 min (20.2 km) Your destination today will be the Dead Sea! you will take a wonderful journey to the Dead Sea, also known as the lowest point on Earth. You will spend the day relaxing by the sea. Try the mineral-rich mud and floating in its waters. You will relax and enjoy its healing properties of the mineral-rich water. Spend the night in Dead Sea!



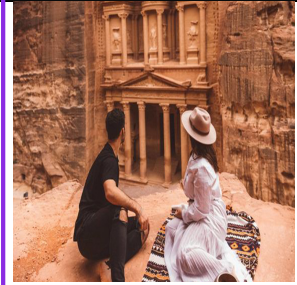
Second Day :Day 2: Dead Sea – Shobak Castle - Petra visit - Wadi Rum visit – Wadi Rum overnight

Distance: 2 hr. 39 min (168.6 km) It's time to head south to Shobak Castle; built by the Crusaders in 1115, is a historic fortress in southern Jordan. It was a key military stronghold in the Crusader period and later fell under Ayyubid, Mamluk, and Ottoman control. Today, it's a popular tourist site known for its medieval architecture and panoramic views.

Distance: 37 min (31.7 km) Then, you will visit one of the Seven Wonders of the World (Petra), Take in the captivating splendour of Jordan's most famous landmark, the rose-red City of Petra, which

is also a UNESCO World Heritage site. Walk through the magnificent Siq, a tiny canyon with towering rocks on either side that serves as the dramatic entrance to Petra, for the first 700 meters of your exploration.

Distance: 1 hr 37 min (104.6 km) Afterward, you will be visiting Wadi Rum; a stunning desert valley located in southern Jordan. It is famous for its breathtaking red sand dunes, towering rock formations, and vast open landscapes. Here you will experience a night under the stars and experience the desert at its fullest, where you can see the sunset while taking a jeep safari tour and then enjoy the Bedouin party & traditional dinner called Zarb. Enjoy the night at your camp!



Third Day :Day 3- Cairo- Amman

You will be driven from Wadi Rum to Queen Alia International Airport in Amman. As you return home or continue to your next destination, think back on the invaluable experiences you had while visiting Jordan. Distance: 3 hr 18 min Fly to Cairo

Salah el-Din Citadel:

It served as Egypt's seat of government till the 1860s, Cairo Citadel is a magnificent fortress. It was constructed during Salah ad-Din reign. The construction work started in 1176 and was completed in 1182. Then pay a visit

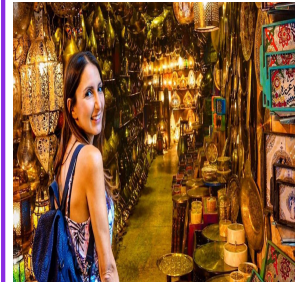
Old Cairo:

Visit Old Cairo to see major attractions such as the Hanging Church, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, the Church of St. Barbara, and the Church of Abu Serga, one of the oldest Coptic churches in Cairo

Mohamed Ali Mosque:

It was constructed between 1830 and 1848, the mosque was named " The Alabaster Mosque" because most of the walls were made of pure alabaster. The mosque is a replica of the Blue Mosque in Istanbul

4Th Day :Day 4-The Pyramids of Giza and Cairo Museum

On this Trip you will see Giza pyramids which were built as tombs of the pharaohs, these pyramids have stood over the years not only as monumental structures but also as a symbol of power

Do you think that the greatness has stopped when you see the sphinx your answer will be No as you will see a rock sculpture with a head of a pharaoh and the body of a lion, and then you will have a Trip to see Khafraa's valley of the temple

After witnessing the greatness of the pyramids you will be hungry.So let's take a break for a delicious Egyptian lunch where you will lose your mind because of the most tasty food you will eat

Tired?! Not now as it is the time of the fabulous Egyptian museum that contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history. It houses the world's largest collection of pharaonic antiquated

Then you will move on to the Egyptian Museum which features artifacts from the Pharaonic period. The museum displays a rare collection of 5000 years of art which is considered the largest most precious collection of Egyptian art in the world. Over 250,000 genuine artifacts are presented.

If you wish to visit the mummy's royal hall, where you will have the feeling of strolling down the Valley of the Kings where most of these mummies were originally resting then ask your Tripguide to



take you to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. It will cost 50 \$ Extra per person.

Optional Tour to the grand Egyptian museum

The Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM) is currently in its trial opening phase, which began in October 2024. Visitors can explore several key sections, including the Great Hall, the Grand Staircase, and 12 main galleries showcasing artifacts from various periods of Egyptian history. However, some sections, such as the Tutankhamun galleries, remain closed and will be accessible upon the museum's full official opening, which is expected at a later date?????.

Tickets for the trial phase are available, with pricing varying for Egyptians and foreign visitors. The museum operates daily, with extended hours on weekends. It's advisable to plan for a half-day visit to fully enjoy the open areas

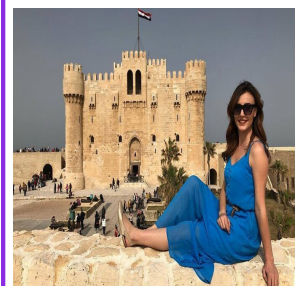

5th Day :Day 5 Day Tour to Alexandria from Cairo

Start your amazing Tour from [Cairo](#) to Alexandria by Private A/C Vehicle. We recommend to start between 07:00 and 07:30 to get enough time in Alexandria as the distance is 220 k/m Northwest of Cairo. Arrive at [Alexandria](#) around 10 am on the way we have one stop for coffee break

Start your day tour in [Alexandria](#) by visiting the Catacombs Kom el Shoqafa:

Archaeologists believe that the catacomb of Kom el Shoqafa was started in the 2nd century A.D. and was used to intern the dead for the next 200 years. This was a period in the history of the city of [Alexandria](#) when there was a great mixture of different cultures. Of course, there was the ancient history of the great Egyptian kingdoms which went back thousands of years



Then Proceed to visit Pompey Pillar:

Has nothing to do with Pompey. The story behind the name refers to the possible burial ground of the Roman general when he fled to Egypt and was assassinated after losing a major battle in Greece against Caesar. The red granite column was probably built to honour Emperor Diocletian. Today it stands 25 meters high and is the tallest ancient monument in [Alexandria](#)

Followed by Visit to The Citadel of Sultan Qaitbay:

The Citadel was built in the 15th Century by the Mamlouk Sultan Qaitbay, to Guard the city against the threat of Crusaders, this wonderful Islamic monument was built by the use of the ruins of the old Lighthouse that was constructed by Ptolemy 11 in 3rd Century A.c. The Lighthouse was damaged during an Earthquake that Occurred in Egypt in 1303 A.c during the reign of the Mamlouk King Qaitbay
