First Day :Day 1: Queen Alia Airport – Amman overnight

Welcome to Jordan! After your arrival in Jordan, our representative will be by your side to assist you in all procedures inside the airport & will guide you to your transfer. Then you'll be heading to your hotel in Amman to rest and get ready for many adventures the next day.

Distance: 37 min (36.8 km)



Second Day :Day 2- Day 2: Amman Hotel – Jerash Visit - Ajloun Visit - Amman Overnight

After Breakfast you will make a tour north starting from Jerash.

Jerash:

The ancient city of Jerash is one of the most popular attractions in Jordan behind Petra. It is considered one of the largest and most well-preserved sites of Roman architecture in the world outside of Italy and its history goes back more than 6,500 years. The city's golden age came under Roman rule, during which time it was known as Gerasa, and the site is now generally acknowledged to be one of the best-preserved Roman provincial towns in the world.

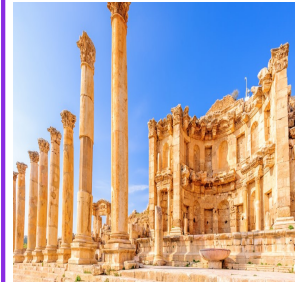
Distance: 58 min (50.7 km)

In Jerash you will explore Jerash Archaeological Museum, south theatre, north theatre, nymphaeum, cathedral, colonnaded street, oval plaza, hippodrome

The second destination today will be Ajloun castle: more formally known as Qal'at Ar-Rabad, towers above the green hills of Ajloun and can be seen from many miles away, betraying its strategic purpose as a military watch post that protected the trade routes in the 12th-15th centuries. It was first built in 1184 by one of Saladin's generals, Izzeldin Usama, to repel the Crusader threats to north Jordan.

Distance: 31 min (18.8 km)

**Third Day :Day 3: Amman Hotel – Madaba Visit – Mount Nebo Visit – Baptism site visit
-Dead**

Distance: 42 min (35.8 km) On this day, you will make a tour in Madaba; is a combination of rural home life and a hot spot for religious tourism. Known as the “City of Mosaics”, Madaba is the cultural epicentre for Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Just a short distance from the capital, visitors are just a stone's throw away from the holy monuments of religious iconography. During your stay in Madaba you will visit St George's Church: This rather modest 19th-century Greek Orthodox church houses a treasure of early Christianity. Imagine the excitement in 1884 when Christian builders came across the remnants of a Byzantine church on their construction site. Among the rubble, having survived wilful destruction, fire and neglect, the flooring they discovered wasn't just another mosaic but one with extraordinary significance: to this day, it represents the oldest map of Palestine in existence and provides many historical insights into the region

Distance: 15 min (9.0 km) Then you'll heading to Mount Nebo: Mount Nebo is the highest point in the ancient Kingdom of Moab, referenced in Abrahamic texts as the site of Mount Nebo this township was first inhabited by a Christian nomadic tribe in the 4th century. Explore your religious roots in the religious town or visit Mt. Nebo where it is believed that Moses died as he viewed the Holy Land. "And Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho.

Distance: 36 min (31.4 km) Now you will visit a Christian pilgrimage site! (Baptism Site) Home to several biblical cities including Sodom, Gomorrah, and Zoar, the archaeological discoveries between the Jordan River and Tal al-Kharrar have identified this area as Biblical “Bethany Beyond the Jordan.” The area is where John was living when he baptized Jesus. Designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site, the Baptism Site commission welcomes pilgrims from all around the world seeking spiritual connection to biblical times, a glimpse of history or a chance to be baptized where Jesus was so many years ago

Distance: 23 min (20.2 km) Then, you will take a wonderful journey to the Dead Sea, also known as the lowest point on Earth. You will spend the day relaxing by the sea. Trying the mineral-rich mud and floating in the water of the Dead Sea You will relax and enjoy the healing properties of the mineral-rich water



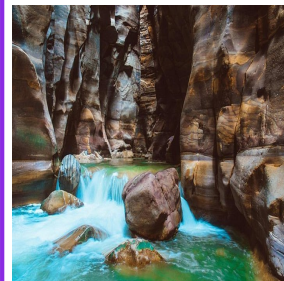

4Th Day :Day 4: Dead Sea – Wadi al Mujib - Shobak Castle - Petra overnight

Distance: 1 hr. 25 min (69.7 km) Today, enjoy your time in Wadi al Mujib. The Mujib Biosphere Reserve is the lowest nature reserve in the world, with a spectacular array of scenery near the east coast of the Dead Sea. The Reserve is located within the deep Wadi Mujib gorge, which enters the Dead Sea 410m below sea level. The Reserve extends to the Karak and Madaba mountains to the north and south, reaching 900 meters above sea level in some places. This 1,300m variation in elevation, combined with the valley's year- round water flow from seven tributaries, means that Wadi Mujib enjoys a magnificent biodiversity that is still being explored and documented today. Over 300 species of plants, 10 species of carnivores and numerous species of permanent and migratory birds have been recorded

Distance: 2 hr. 24 min (177.7 km) It's time to head south to Shobak Castle; Set atop a mountain, Shobak Castle is an enchanting castle that was built in 1115 under the rule of King Baldwin I. Shobak Castle is particularly striking due to its remote location in the desert which will make visitors feel a world away from home. Within the castle grounds, visitors can explore the churches, historic ruins, and a secret passageway that leads to a charming spring. The castle also boasts a watchtower, catacombs and several Christian carvings and Islamic tablets

Distance: 37 min (31.7 km) Ahead to Petra for overnight



5th Day :Day 5: Petra – Petra visit – Wadi Rum visit - Amman overnight

On this day you will visit one of the Seven Wonders of the World (Petra), Take in the captivating splendor of Jordan's most famous landmark, the rose-red City of Petra, which is also a UNESCO World Heritage site. Walk through the magnificent Siq, a tiny canyon with towering rocks on either side that serves as the dramatic entrance to Petra, for the first 700 meters of your exploration.

Also, you will explore the little Petra (Beidha): is a fascinating site due to the similarities with Petra. Like the ancient city of Petra, Al Beidha is constructed behind a narrow canyon which acts as a passageway. The Cold Siq of Al Beidha is slightly smaller than The Siq at Petra and visitors will need to hike through it to reach the ruins of Little Petra. The cliffs that surround the ruins of Little Petra are eroded by wind and are very interesting to see. There are many broken tablets located around the site which dates to the Neolithic period.

Distance: 1 hr. 40 min (104.6 km) Here you will experience a night under the stars and enjoy a full desert vibe, where you can see the sunset in the desert with unforgettable vibes.
