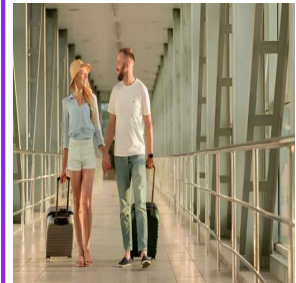

First Day :Day 1: Queen Alia Airport -desert castles Amman overnight

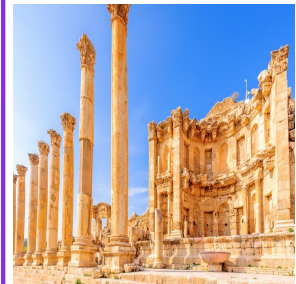
Distance: 1h 0m (79.2 km)/ duration of tour around 3 hours
Welcome to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan! Our representative meets you with a signage in front of the immigration Amman Airport. prepare for a journey to Jordan's desert castles, exquisite examples of early Islamic art and architecture. These castles, dating back to the Umayyad period (7th–8th centuries), were once luxurious retreats, hunting lodges, and trade hubs. Among the most notable are Qasr Amra, Qasr Kharana, Qasr al-Hallabat, Qasr al-Mushatta, and Qasr al-Burqu, each offering a unique glimpse into the past. After a day filled with exploration and history, you'll return to Amman for an overnight stay.



Second Day :Day 2: Jerash – Ajloun - Umm Qais- Amman overnight:

Distance: 48m (50.1 km)/ duration of tour around 2 hours

Today you will make a tour north starting from Jerash. The ancient city of Jerash is one of the most popular attractions in Jordan behind Petra. It is considered one of the largest and most well-preserved sites of Roman architecture in the world outside of Italy and its history goes back more than 6,500 years. The city's golden age came under Roman rule, during which time it was known as Gerasa, and the site is now generally acknowledged to be one of the best-preserved Roman provincial towns in the world. In Jerash you will explore Jerash Archaeological Museum, south theatre, north theatre, nymphaeum, cathedral, colonnaded street, oval plaza, hippodrome. Distance: 31 min (18.8 km)/ duration of tour around 2 hours The second destination today will be Ajloun castle: more formally known as Qal'at Ar Rabad, towers above the green hills of Ajloun and can be seen from many miles away, betraying its strategic purpose as a military watch post that protected the trade routes in the 12th-15th centuries. It was first built in 1184 by one of Saladin's generals, Izzeldin Usama, to repel threader threats to north Jordan. Distance: 31 min (18.8 km)/ duration of tour around 1 hour Also, get ready for an amazing visit to Umm Qais ; was once the thriving Roman city of Gadara. Today the area is home to magnificent ruins which draw thousands of visitors each year. Due to its hilltop location, Umm Qais is a perfect destination for absorbing the picturesque views of the Jordan Valley. There



are many Roman sites at Umm Qais including two ancient theatres. Now return to your hotel in Amman!

Third Day :Day 3: Amman- Petra visit – Wadi Rum overnight:

Distance: 3h 0m (234 km)/duration of tour around 4 hours

Full day visiting Jordan's Jewel "Petra", one of the 7 wonders of the world. You will take a horseback ride, walk through the Siq, the only access to this city. Return back to your hotel in Amman for overnight Distance: 1h 36m (99.9 km)/duration of tour around 2 hours Afterward, you'll head to Wadi Rum, a stunning desert valley known for its majestic red sand dunes and towering sandstone formations. Often referred to as "The Valley of the Moon," Wadi Rum offers one of the most serene and otherworldly landscapes in the world. Here, you'll embark on an exciting Jeep safari, exploring the vast desert and its remarkable natural beauty. As the sun sets, enjoy a traditional Bedouin dinner, known as Zarb, cooked in an underground oven, while gazing at the stars above. Your day will end with an overnight stay at a Bedouin camp in Wadi Rum, where you can unwind and take in the tranquility of the desert night.



4Th Day :Day 4: Wadi Rum – Madaba Visit – Mount Nebo Visit -Dead Sea overnight:

Date: Distance: 42 min (35.8 km) /duration of tour around 2 hours

On this day, you will make a tour in Madaba; is a combination of rural home life and a hot spot for religious tourism. Known as the "City of Mosaics", Madaba is the cultural epicentre for Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Just a short distance from the capital, visitors are just a stone's throw away from the holy monuments of religious iconography. During your stay in Madaba you will visit St George's Church: This rather modest 19th-century Greek Orthodox church houses a treasure of early Christianity. Imagine the excitement in 1884 when Christian builders came across the remnants of a Byzantine church on their construction site. Among the rubble, having survived wilful destruction, fire and neglect, the flooring they discovered wasn't just another mosaic but one with extraordinary significance: to this day, it represents the oldest map of Palestine in existence and provides many historical insights into the region Distance: 15 min (9.0 km)/duration of tour around 1 hour Then you'll heading to Mount Nebo: Mount Nebo is the highest point in the ancient Kingdom of Moab, referenced in



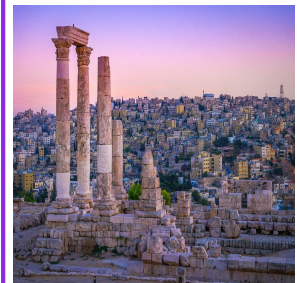
Abrahamic texts as the site of Mount Nebo this township was first inhabited by a Christian nomadic tribe in the 4th century. Explore your religious roots in the religious town [Type here] or visit Mt. Nebo where it is believed that Moses died as he viewed the Holy Land. "And Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho Distance: 15m (9.1 km)/ duration of tour around 2 hours Then, you will take a wonderful journey to the Dead Sea, also known as the lowest point on Earth. You will spend the day relaxing by the sea. Trying the mineral-rich mud and floating in the water of the Dead Sea.

5th Day :Day 5: Dead Sea – Amman city tour - King Abdullah Mosque – Queen Alia Airport:

Distance: 57m (54.1 km)/ duration of tour around 4 hours begin your journey with a visit to the iconic King Abdullah I Mosque. Known for its striking blue dome and elegant architecture, the mosque offers a peaceful introduction to Jordan's rich spiritual and cultural heritage. As you walk through the serene prayer halls and admire the intricate Islamic designs, you'll gain a deeper appreciation for the country's history and traditions. It's the perfect first stop to connect with the beauty and harmony of Amman before continuing your adventure.

today is a tour of Amman City, beginning with a pick-up from your hotel by our driver. You'll be taken to the Amman Citadel, also known as Jebel Al Qalaa, one of the city's most iconic and historic landmarks. Situated on one of the seven hills that make up the capital, the Citadel features remarkable ruins, including the grand Hercules Temple, the Ayyubid Watchtower, and the renowned Great Hand Statue, alongside other structures that date back to ancient times. Next, you'll visit the ancient Roman Theatre, an impressive structure once used for musical performances. With a capacity of 6,000 people, this theatre is still used today for similar events, preserving its rich cultural legacy. Following the theatre, we'll visit the Archaeological Museum, housing a fascinating collection of ancient artefacts, offering a deeper understanding of Jordan's historical significance.

Distance: 36m (35.3 km) You will be driven from Amman to Queen Alia International Airport in Amman. As you return home or continue to your next destination, think back on the invaluable experiences you've had while visiting Jordan.
