Transfer to Rosetta

The journey from Alexandria Port to Rosetta covers approximately 60 km and takes around 1 to 1.5 hours. To ensure a smooth trip. Snacks and drinks will also be provided during the drive to keep you refreshed.

The Citadel of Qaitbay

Upon arrival in Rosetta, visit the Citadel of Qaitbay, a beautifully preserved 15th-century fortress built to protect the Nile's mouth from invasions. Wander through its impressive walls and towers as your expert guide shares fascinating stories about its historical significance during the Mamluk period and beyond.

Rosetta Stone

The Rosetta Stone was discovered in mid-July 1799 by a French officer named Pierre-François Bouchard, while French soldiers were conducting construction work at the Fort Saint Julien (the Citadel of Qaitbay) near the city of Rosetta, in the Beheira Governorate, northern Egypt) during Napoleon Bonaparte's French campaign in Egypt.

It was found partially buried in the ground and was being used as building material for the fort. At the time, the soldiers did not realize its significance, but scientists later noticed that it bore inscriptions in three languages. The Rosetta Stone is the linguistic and historical treasure that opened the door to understanding ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic writing and led to the complete rediscovery of Pharaonic civilization.

City of Rosetta

Stroll through the charming streets of Rosetta, a city famous for its well-preserved Ottoman architecture. Admire the traditional houses with their unique mashrabiya balconies and experience the authentic atmosphere of this historic town where the famous



Rosetta Stone was discovered.

Hamмам Azouz

Next, explore Hammam Azouz, one of the oldest public baths in Rosetta. Discover the ingenious design and the social importance of hammams in Ottoman-era daily life, as your guide explains the traditions and rituals associated with these communal spaces.

Lunch at a Local Restaurant

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant in Rosetta. Savor a variety of fresh seafood and traditional Egyptian dishes, taking in the relaxing riverside ambiance before continuing your tour.

Abou Shaheen Mill

After lunch, visit the historic Abou Shaheen Mill, a well-preserved example of the ancient grain mills that once powered Rosetta's economy. Your guide will walk you through the mill's mechanisms and highlight its role in the city's thriving trade network.

National Museum of Rosetta

Transfer to Alexandria Port
